What do you like about spring?

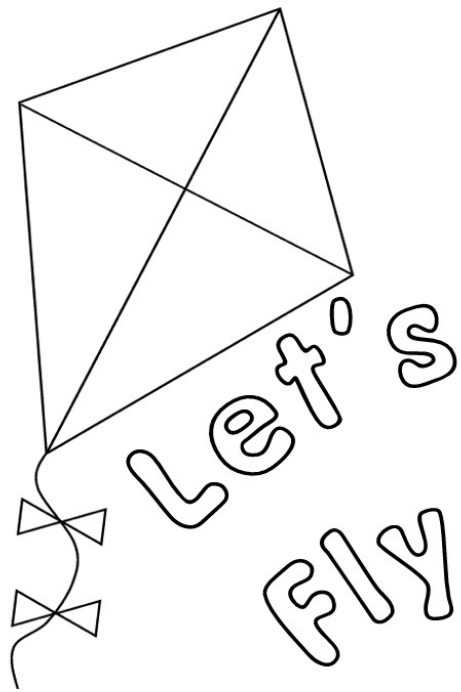
What living things do you like to see in spring?	Top Left Quadrant

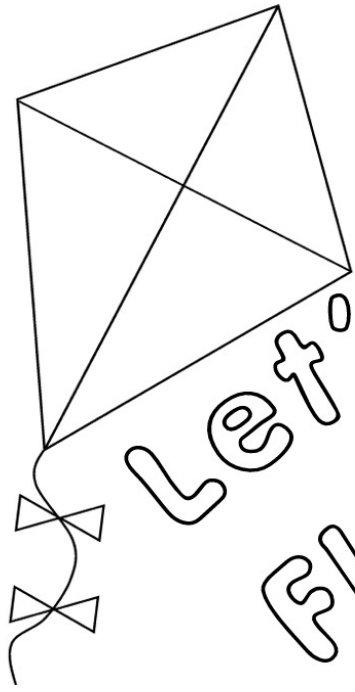

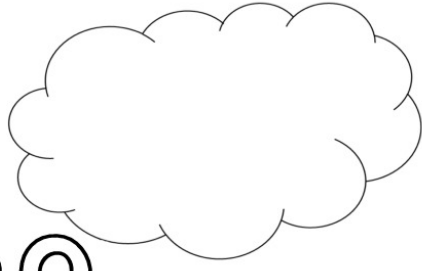
